Created for Eye Music in 2009, Moonorooni was designed and built in Wales by *Cwmni Colourscape* - the renowned partnership of artists *Peter Jones* and *Lynne Dickens*.

The latest in a family of walk-through sculptures of colour, Moonorooni brings together the best elements of its larger sister sculptures. Visitors are invited to wander freely through the interconnected chambers and experience the dazzling effects of pure primary colours, illuminated only by sunlight. Opaque chambers reflect and blend the primaries together to produce rainbow pathways of sublime secondary colours. This is a magical environment where colour is experienced physically.

At specified times, musicians, dancers, acrobats or illusionists add a stimulating performance element to this extraordinary world. See daily programme for details.
